



Behavior Management

This year we are implementing a new behavior management system called **1-2-3 Magic!** Every teacher in the building will be following this new system. If you are a returning parent your child **WILL** still be able to earn an Eagle Egg for showing focus, respect, effort, and safety. The Eagle Eggs are special rewards given to students showing excellent behavior. This is a school wide positive behavior program. When your child receives an eagle egg, one copy is sent to the office and the other copy is sent home with the child. ☺

1-2-3 Magic!

1. If your child has difficulty following rules they will be told, "That is a 1."
2. If your child continues to have difficulty following rules they will be told, "That is a 2."
3. If your child continues to have difficulty following rules they will be told, "That is a 3, take 5." Take 5 is a 5-minute time out.
4. This process will continue and if the student reaches 3 again, the student and teacher will fill out a Reflection form.
5. This process will continue and if the student reaches 3 again, the student and teacher will fill out a Minor Incident Report form.
6. This process will continue and if the student reaches 3 again, the student will be given an office referral and talk with one of our principals.

Please make sure to SIGN the Reflection Forms and Minor Incident Reports and return them to school the following day. Also talk with your child about their behavior and consequences.

****An Office referral is used with behaviors that disrupt instruction and threaten others: hitting, kicking, biting, etc.****

Each day, ask your child how they did and look for their eagle eggs!
